Award Title: The New Zealand Aid Programme Award

For Excellence for a business that helps solves a development problem.

Descriptor:

The focus of the New Zealand Government's Aid Programme is on sustainable development in developing countries, in order to reduce poverty and contribute to a more secure, equitable and prosperous world. Within this objective there is a core focus on sustainable economic development and Pacific countries. Support to private sector development, in particular small-medium business is a key component of the economic development spectrum. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade is very pleased to be associated with this award linking business entrepreneurship with development.

Award Title: Gallagher Group Award for Social Enterprise

For: Companies who recognise social challenges and use entrepreneurial principles to organise, manage and create a positive change in the community will be considered.

Result in a strong and sustainable improvement

Award Title: NZICA Young Managing Director of the Year Award"

For: The YES Managing Director who most effectively demonstrates leadership and who contributes to the success of their company.

Descriptor:

The Managing Director will need to demonstrate constructive leadership behavior and be able to provide examples in a video clip or statement. Judging will be based on the following four components.

1. Company Overall Competition mark
(oral presentation 30%, coordinators marks 40%, annual report 30%)
2. Nomination from YES team members
3. Endorsement of nomination from your YES teacher or YES mentor
4. Video Clip (up to 2 minutes) or statement of leadership style and behavior with examples of leadership styles to explain your leadership style and how that has been successful in managing the team

Submit with your video CD or written statement and nomination form with your company annual report according to the instructions for all national awards.

In addition to the cash prize of \$1000 and a trophy, this award includes an all expenses paid trip to the NZICA Leadership Awards in Wellington on 30 November.
